Set Ups, Check In, Start Times

April 19—21, 2024

Preliminary running order contingent on move up entries not yet received. Per AKC rules, the move up deadline is 6 pm on Monday, April 1, 2023. No move ups for Friday will be allowed after this time and date. Move ups for Saturday and Sunday must be given to the Trial Secretary, at the show site, in writing within 15 minutes of the last dog completing the course on Friday or Saturday.

Novice B/A Standard and JWW classes will run together by jump heights with division B running before division A. Master/Excellent Standard and JWW classes will run together by jump heights with Master running before Excellent.

FAST will run together by height. The Preferred classes will run intermingled with the Regular classes by height.

Lunch breaks will be at the Judge's discretion.

A warm up area, consisting of a regulation agility jump, will be provided.

Check in will begin

Friday: 10:30 am

Saturday: 8:00 am

Sunday: 8:00 am

Exhibitors are not required to check in at these times but should plan to arrive in plenty of time for course walking and measurement of dog if necessary.

Judging will begin

Friday: 11:00 am

Saturday: 8:30 am

Sunday: 8:30 am

Walk through will begin as soon as the Judge has approved the course.

First course in each ring, exhibitors must walk both courses before first dog in either ring.

Walks will be split into two groups for: Master/Excellent Standard & JWW plus FAST on Saturday.

Crating

The arena has covered crating, on grass, located on berms along both long sides of the arena. The covered crating area on the side closest to RV parking is reserved for

Secretary, Minions, Bearded Show Committee. The opposite side is general crating

Ring Size—100 x 100 on dirt.

Food and Beverages

The Coffee Shack will be open Saturday and Sunday until 9 am. The Café will be open for breakfast and lunch.

Good news!!! The worker vouchers can be used to purchase food and beverages.

All About Height Cards

All dogs, regardless of jump height, who are under two years of age and do not have a temporary height card or are over two years of age and do not have a permanent height card must be measured prior

to their first run of the weekend. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to ensure their dog is measured before their first run. Measurement of dogs will take place near the score table throughout

the day when Beverly Morgan Lewis and Lori Sage are not otherwise occupied. Measurement will "count" toward dog's permanent height card.

Ken Boyd has designed all courses. Ken will judge all courses except Master/Excellent JWW and Premier JWW on Saturday and Sunday.

Laura Finco will judge Master/Excellent JWW and Premier JWW Saturday and Sunday. Both rings will run at the same time during Master/Excellent JWW

First Course Each Morning



Each day exhibitors will walk both of the first courses in each ring before judging begins. Judging will move from the Standard to the JWW ring after a 10 minute break.

Friday: exhibitors walk Master/Excellent Standard and JWW before 11:00 am.

Saturday: exhibitors will walk Master/Excellent Standard and JWW before 8:30 am.

FAST will be split into two walk groups. Group 1 heights 20-24 and Group 2 heights 4-16. Both groups walk before judging begins

Sunday: exhibitors will walk T2B and Master/Excellent JWW before 8:30 am. Small dogs will walk JWW first then T2B. Large dogs will walk T2B first then JWW. Master/Excellent Standard will be split into two walk groups. Both groups will walk before judging begins.

Scores & Awards

Results: each day, for that day only, hard copies will be posted. At the end of each day results will be posted on the main website.

Ribbons: Before touching anything, use the provided hand sanitizer. Agility ribbons will be located near the agility rings. There will be a clipboard at the awards table. If the ribbon labels are ready then the daily awards form, located on the front of the clipboard, will be initialed next to that class. All scores MUST be verified by the judge BEFORE ribbons can be released.

Driving and Parking

Agility Gate

Exhibitors are requested to download the free phone app called Agility Gate.

If you have an Apple phone or device go to iOS or iPadOS and download the PURPLE app called Agility Gate. You will need your Apple password.

If you have a Droid phone or device go to Google Play Store and download the PURPLE app called Agility Gate. You will need your Google password.

Through the app exhibitors will check in, mark a conflict or scratch. The app answers the question of who is currently competing, who is next and how many before their dog. The show code is 9316. Make a note in your phone. **Any event with Lorie Abbott ABBA Dogs a Secretary will have the same show code = 9316.**

To check in, conflict or scratch – touch your dog’s name and swipe left. This means from the right side of the screen to the left side of the screen. The run order/groups will be live on the app the morning of the event.

Hard copy gate sheets will not be printed. Instead there will be a computer monitor near the ring with the run order posted live.


You will not need your phone at the gate. The gate steward will call out dog names just like in the past. If you have multiple dogs running too close together in the run order tell the Crew Chief or Gate Steward at the ring. They will move your dog. All moves, scratches will immediately upload to app and been seen on everyone’s phone.

If you do not have a Smart Phone, do not worry. At the event, the Crew Chief, Gate Steward or Main Score Table can check in, scratch or move your dog.



Bradley Ranch Road is a rural road. Speed limit is 25 mph.

Turn right onto this lane 




Follow Takemori to the end. Turn left. Main parking lot will be on your right.

On your left will be rows of horse stalls. You may park alongside the stalls. This means your vehicle parks close to the stalls with a drivable space down the center of the aisles. This DOES NOT mean you may crate in the stalls. We have not paid to use the stalls.



For those in RVs. As you approach the ranch look for this sign on your left.



Seems explanatory but to be clear....

RV information will be posted on this sign. RV spaces are marked and assigned. Each has power and water.



Central dump is located near the rental RVs.

Those staying on the ranch overnight are welcome to use the pool. NO DOGS in or around the pool area.

You are not required to check in at these time however, you should plan to arrive in plenty of time for course walk and, if necessary measurement of dog.

The rings will run continuous except for course walking and building.

For Standard Dogs calculate 90 seconds for each dog in the class.

For all other classes calculate 60 seconds per dog.

For course building calculate 10 minutes.

For course walk calculate 8 minutes per group plus 5 minutes to "get your dog".

Step 1: Complete the form

Step 2: Place in the black plastic basket used to collect scribe sheets. This will be a basket at the main score.

Move up forms must be given to the Trial Secretary, at the show site, in writing within 15 minutes of the last dog completing the course on Friday, Saturday or Sunday.


